At the September 7, 2006 TOT Hearings, the Board requested a report back regarding who is responsible under the current lease for capital expenses at the Cherry Island Soccer Complex.

California Youth Soccer Association (CYSA), under a ten year lease agreement with the County, operates and maintains the Cherry Island Soccer Complex. At the signing of the lease agreement in 2000, it was estimated that the lease saved the Department over \$117,000 annually in operating costs. CYSA is responsible for scheduling leagues and tournaments, and maintaining the fields, landscaped areas, irrigation system and structures. The CYSA operations budget is funded by fees, and is augmented by TOT funds.

The Agreements specifies that the County is responsible for:

- providing domestic water service,
- water for irrigation,
- night security lighting,
- electricity,
- and electrical repairs for irrigation and night security lighting.

It further states that the County is <u>not</u> responsible for:

• any repairs of the facilities and equipment associated with the complex (except as noted above).

The agreement also states that the County will not reimburse the CYSA for repairs made to the facility or equipment associated with the complex, and that the CYSA at its sole discretion may elect to make repairs or close the facility and cancel the agreement.

The Agreement does not specify responsibility for capital improvement projects, but does allow for CYSA to make improvements with the Parks Director concurrence. Parks has allocated \$100,000 from Tobacco Litigation Funds towards a new restroom structure at the complex. CYSA has committed to soliciting volunteers and donations to make improvements to the existing restrooms.
