Before the Northwest Station House relocates, we will examine the need to establish a Community Service Center in the Elverta/Rio Linda/Antelope area.

When the law enforcement contract with Elk with Elk Grove terminates, the city will need to relocate its police operations elsewhere. The Sheriff has no plans to vacate the Bond Road facility. We are working with the County Executive's Office and County Real Estate to examine the facility requirements and costs involved in relocating the Communications Dispatch Center from 711 G Stwith the most likely site being the Bond Road Facility which the County owns. The recent hurricane disasters have heightened the concerns about being able to maintain effective emergency communications during any disaster. 711 G. St lies within the flood plain, and a disaster of the magnitude of Katrina could either destroy or severely disable emergency communications at a time when they are most needed. We will work with the County to determine if any seismic retrofitting of Bond Road is needed to enable it to house the 911 dispatch center. The total cost to move the dispatch center could run from \$2.3 - \$6.0 million depending upon if seismic retrofitting is required. We have \$1.0M in State 911 financing available. There have been inquiries from the City of Elk Grove and the Elk Grove Community Services District relating to a possible purchase or lease of the Bond Road facility. The first priority must be to ensure that the Communications Dispatch Center is housed in a safe, secure site. Once plans for this have
