Special Districts Budget Summaries

CSA 4B– This district's fund balance is \$7,834 less than last year's actual due to less spending variance from budget.

CSA 4C- This district's fund balance is \$5,576 less than last year's actual due to less spending variance from budget.

CSA 4D- This district's fund balance is \$14,032 less than last year's actual due to less spending variance from budget.

Mission Oaks Park District – This district's fund balance is \$339,088 less than last year's actual due to a significant increase in reserve provision in 2004-05.

Carmichael Park District – This district's revenues are \$779,606 less than last year's due to less anticipated funding from state grants.

Sunrise Park District – This district's revenues are \$2,371,400 less than last year's due to a reduction in park development fees transferred into operating budget for construction projects.

Del Norte Oaks Park Maintenance District – This district's fund balance is \$1,330 less than last year's actual due to less spending variance from budget.

Mission Oaks Maintenance and Improvement District – This district's fund balance is \$531,568 less than last year's actual due to a significant increase in reserve provision in 2004-05.

Natomas Fire District – This district's fund balance is \$224,503 higher than last year's actual due to increased revenues and lower than anticipated expenditures in 2004-05.
