Projected Savings Alternative for Fee Management of Maintenance Services

Summary

The projected estimated savings if golf operations at each course were placed under fee management are contained in the following chart. The projected savings is conservative, and actual savings may be higher as demonstrated in Table 7 of the report.

Services and Supplies

Some services and supply accounts, such as utility costs will remain the same whether or not the golf course maintenance is contracted. The following list of service and supply accounts realizing a net savings from each golf course.

Services for vehicles, pumps, alarms and building maintenance (such as electrical or plumbing) will be provided by either golf course personnel already on site, or independent contractors, instead of County personnel. Golf course concessionaires, because of the number of golf courses they manage and specialization in the golf industry, allow for greater competitive pricing than the County can receive at its general bidding process.

Savings in County Administration and Overhead

In addition to Personnel and Services & Supplies, there are other budget items which will realize a savings from each golf course.
