EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Sacramento County is a partner in the Sacramento Public Library Authority that provides library services and operates libraries in the County. The County is responsible for planning, constructing, and financing library facilities within the county's jurisdiction. Impact fees levied on new developments provide a portion of financing available for library construction. Projects proposed to be completed in the 2008-09 Fiscal Year Capital Budget include an "Operating Budget Impact" statement.

• Rio Linda Library-New Library -- Rio Linda has no independent source of funding for library facilities. In 2000, the Board of Supervisors allocated \$1.2 million financing from the 2001 Tobacco Litigation Settlement-Capital Project Fund to finance the design and construction documents for the new Rio Linda library. On October 23, 2007, the Board of Supervisors approved an additional allocation of \$528,735 from unallocated 2001 Tobacco Litigation Settlement funds. The Library Authority, in partnership with Sacramento County, hopes to secure the balance of the funding to construct the new library. The estimated amount shown here is only for the design costs associated with the new library. Estimated Total Cost: \$1,728,735

The County is responsible for the financing and construction of branch libraries throughout the County. New libraries are financed through impact fee programs generated by development within growth areas. However, Rio Linda has no impact fee programs upon which to rely. On September 5, 2000, the Board of Supervisors approved \$1.2 million for a Rio Linda Library from the Tobacco Litigation Settlement. This funding, together with Library capital funds, will finance the design and estimate for the construction of a new library. Funding for the construction of the new library has not been identified. The new Rio Linda Library will serve the educational and recreational needs of youth, adults, and seniors of the community.

Operating Budget Impact:

The operating cost impact of this project is unknown at this time.
