SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION (Recommended Budget Letter)

The anticipated funding available within the Capital Construction Fund for Fiscal Year 2014-15 is \$33,893,536. The Fiscal Year 2014-15 Recommended Budget includes several high priority projects in the County's Justice Facilities as well as projects at other county facilities.
